## Preface

Pendidikan kesetaraan sebagai pendidikan alternatif memberikan layanan kepada masyarakat yang karena kondisi geografis, sosial budaya, ekonomi dan psikologis tidak berkesempatan mengikuti pendidikan dasar dan menengah di jalur pendidikan formal. Kurikulum pendidikan kesetaraan dikembangkan mengacu pada kurikulum 2013 pendidikan dasar dan menengah hasil revisi berdasarkan peraturan Mendikbud No.24 tahun 2016. Proses adaptasi kurikulum 2013 ke dalam kurikulum pendidikan kesetaraan adalah melalui proses kontekstualisasi dan fungsionalisasi dari masing-masing kompetensi dasar, sehingga peserta didik memahami makna dari setiap kompetensi yang dipelajari.

Pembelajaran pendidikan kesetaraan menggunakan prinsip flexible learning sesuai dengan karakteristik peserta didik kesetaraan. Penerapan prinsip pembelajaran tersebut menggunakan sistem pembelajaran modular dimana peserta didik memiliki kebebasan dalam penyelesaian tiap modul yang di sajikan. Konsekuensi dari sistem tersebut adalah perlunya disusun modul pembelajaran pendidikan kesetaraan yang memungkinkan peserta didik untuk belajar dan melakukan evaluasi ketuntasan secara mandiri.

Tahun 2017 Direktorat Pembinaan Pendidikan Keaksaraan dan Kesetaraan, Direktorat Jendral Pendidikan Anak Usia Dini dan Pendidikan Masyarakat mengembangkan modul pembelajaran pendidikan kesetaraan dengan melibatkan pusat kurikulum dan perbukuan kemdikbud, para akademisi, pamong belajar, guru dan tutor pendidikan kesetaraan. Modul pendidikan kesetaraan disediakan mulai paket A tingkat kompetensi 2 (kelas 4 Paket A). Sedangkan untuk peserta didik Paket A usia sekolah, modul tingkat kompetensi 1 (Paket A setara SD kelas 1-3) menggunakan buku pelajaran Sekolah Dasar kelas 1-3, karena mereka masih memerlukan banyak bimbingan guru/tutor dan belum bisa belajar secara mandiri.



Suggestion is an idea about what someone should do or how someone should behave. (<https://www.merriam-webster.com/dictionary/suggestion>)

If we make a suggestion, it means that we mention a possible course of action to someone.

Beside the expressions above, there are some ways to ask how to ask, to give, and to respond to suggestions.

Asking Suggestions	Giving Suggestions	Responses
What should I do for her?	You should buy this car.	You're right.
What do you think he should do for her?	He should give more attention to her.	I agree with you.
Should she come to the party?	No, she shouldn't. She should not come to the party.	I disagree with you.
Do you think he ought to call the boss?	Yes, he ought to call the boss.	I think so.
Do you have any suggestions for me?	You ought to have a picnic.	Thanks. It sounds great.
	Why not take a sleep?	
	Why don't we read a book?	
Any idea?	How about buying a book?	That's a good idea.
	How about a cup of coffee?	
	What about cooking some food with grandma?	I don't think it's a good idea.
	Let's take a rest.	
	We could go to Bromo.	

Generally, we use some terms and patterns to give suggestions, such as *should*, *ought to*, *why not*, *why don't*, *how about*, *what about*, *let's*, and *could*.

- should

### Positive form

**Subject + should + verb 1 + obj. + adv.\***

Examples:

1. You should buy this car.
2. You should come to my house everyday .

\*Use adverb if it is necessary.

### Negative form

**Subject + should not (shouldn't) + v 1 + obj. + adv.**

Examples:

1. You should not buy this car.
2. You shouldn't come to my house everyday .

### Interrogative form

**Should + subject + verb 1 ?**

Examples:

1. Should she come to the party?  
(+) Yes, she should.  
(-) No, she shouldn't.
2. Should I buy this car?  
(+) Yes, you should.  
(-) No, you shouldn't.

- ought to

### Positive form

**Subject + ought to + verb 1 + obj. + adv.\***

Examples:

1. You ought to have a picnic.
2. He ought to give her explanation.

### Negative form

**Subject + ought not + v 1 + obj. + adv.**

Examples:

1. You ought not to have a picnic.
2. He ought not to give her explanation.

Note: There is no interrogative form of "ought to".

- why not....?

**Why not + verb 1 + object ?**

Examples:

1. Why not take a sleep?
2. Why not drink a glass of juice?

- why don't....?

**Why don't + S + verb 1 + object ?**

Examples:

1. Why don't we read a book?
2. Why don't you take an English course?

- how about....?

**How about + verb ing + object ?**

Examples:

1. How about fishing?
2. How about making some dounuts?

- what about

**What about + verb ing + object ?**

Examples:

1. What about fishing?
2. What about making some dounuts?

Note: "How about" and "what about" is considered have the same meaning.

**Let's + verb + object**

Examples:

1. Let's take a rest.
2. Let's have a lunch.

- could

**subject + could + verb 1 + object**

Examples:

1. We could go to Bromo.
2. You could give them some food.




